Senator Ensign Helps Wildlife

A grant spearheaded by Nevada's Senator John Ensign is providing Wild Wing Project and Nevada's wildlife with greatly needed help.

The grant monies have allowed Wild Wing Project to purchase special life-saving equipment such as hospital units, brooders and incubators and food unique to various wildlife species. This special equipment is already saving lives! The grant has provided a computer, printer, copier and facsimile machine, plus textbooks and videos used to teach the latest and best protocols for wildlife rescue and rehabilitation. Wild Wing Project has also used the grant to purchase medications, special dietary supplements, nets, bathing pans and a freezer and refrigerator not to mention a forty nine-foot-long fight for our Raven and Roadrunners.

This grant provides much needed relief for Wild Wing Project after more than a 20+ year struggle of soliciting donations and privately paying for and providing healthcare, medications and food to rescue, rehabilitate and release many species of wildlife from Hummingbirds, Herons and hawks to Eagles and many, many others.

Now, plans for a state-of-the-art Rehabilitation and Wildlife Education Center are moving forward, again, thanks to Senator Ensign and his staff. The Center is long overdue and will be a welcome addition to the Las Vegas area.
